Dear Sir,

Group mediclaim scheme for the employees

This is further to our letters dated 11th April, 2009 and 30th January, 2010 on the above subject.

Through the above two letters we were representing to you (1) for increase in the basic sum insured and (2) for providing subsidy in premium to the retired employees.

We pointed out about the heavy increase in premiums which was a huge burden particularly on the retired employees. We requested you to introduce subsidy in the premium for the retired employees also, so that LIC may provide an element of continued medical assistance to those who spent the prime of their life in the service of the Corporation.

We are happy that when the undersigned met you on 13th March 2010 and broached the subject, you assured to look into these demands.

Subsequently, on 19th March 2010, when we had discussions with the Managing Director and other officials, we once again reminded them of our request on the issues relating to mediclaim.

We are writing this letter to you once again to recapitulate our representations on these two issues, since the renewal of the Medclaim Scheme is being discussed with the Insurers and it is the time to take favourable decisions on these two issues.
