### **Correction in the name of Working Committee Member:**



### **Temporary Employees:**

Some of our units are enquiring about the case of Temporary employees of Hyderabad which is being taken up in the Supreme Court. The temporary employees of Hyderabad and Secunderabad have been working for the last 15 years to 20 years. When they approached the Andhra Pradesh High Court, the High Court ruled in their favour. LIC went on appeal to Supreme Court. During the Conference of AIIEA the issue relating to Temporary employees was discussed and the General Secretary, AIIEA informed about this position. Our Divisional Units at Hyderabad are providing the necessary support to the temporary employees with regard to the defence in the petition.

When the AIIEA delegation was in the Central Office on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2010 (refer our circular no.23/2010 dated 10<sup>th</sup> December 2010) we were informed by Our Hyderabad Divisional Union that the matter came up for hearing on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2010 in the Supreme Court where the Judges observed that LIC should come out with a solution to the temporary employees who are working for longer durations and posted the matter for hearing on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2011. It was in this background that we placed our suggestions before the Officials of the LIC for an amicable solution to the issue of temporary employees working in LIC.
