POST CARD CAMPAIGN

Working Committee of AIIEA which met at Chennai in December 2009, called upon the units to mobilise a minimum of 1000 postcards from each branch office addressed to the Prime Minister reflecting the opinion of the Policyholders and urging withdrawal of the Insurance Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2008 and the LIC (Amendment) Bill 2009 which are neither in the interest of the policyholders nor in the interest of the nation.

This call was taken up in all earnest by the units and a total of 17,36,968 postcards were sent to the Prime Minister as per the information compiled by the Zonal Units/Standing Committee (GI) so far.


