Re: Agitation on EDMS called off

We confirm having sent the following SMS message to all our Units on 22.07.2008 in regard to the above:

“The Zonal Management has agreed to EDMS payment @ 50 paise (plus 10 paise by Sr.DM). They have also cleared two cases of compassionate appointment and have assured to move further. Apart from 15 Assistant vacancies declared for ZO, they have assured to work out other vacancies. Discussion likely in third week of next month. MD and ED (Personnel) have also assured AIIEA to intervene and advise Zonal Office suitably. Agitational programme on EDMS called off. Circular follows.”

You are aware that as per the decision of the ECZIEA Secretariat Meeting held at Berhampur on 18th May, 2008, our units and members all over the Zone observed the programme with grit and determination, particularly the five Divisions where EDMS was taken up in the first phase eg. Patna, Muzaffarpur, Cuttack, Jamshedpur and Hazaribagh. Our Divisional Units observed the programmes with all sincerity and firmness. The ECZIEA, when approached by the Zonal Management, also urged upon them to settle the demands in the spirit of the Zonal management's assurance of March 2008. The AIIEA also urged upon the Central Office management to intervene and advise the ECZ management to honour their commitment and create a conducive condition in the Zone.

All these efforts have yielded results. The Zonal management have cleared two cases of compassionate appointment and assured of early movement on the remaining ones. On EDMS, they have also agreed to pay @ 60 paise per

docket (out of which 10 paise will be the SDM's discretion). Besides announcing 15 Assistants vacancies for the Zonal Office, they have assured to work out other vacancies and discuss the matter with us at the earliest, in all likelihood in mid August. In view of these developments, the ECZIEA has decided to call off the EDMS boycott programme.

We congratulate all our units and members for successful implementation of the agitational programme, which alone has enabled us to achieve the successes mentioned above. This should inspire us to move ahead to secure the unmet demands. We hope and urge upon the Zonal Management to keep their commitment and fulfill the legitimate demands in the best interest of all concerned.
