Re: Patna Division II Finalised

We are very happy to inform that one more Division has come up in East Central Zone of LIC in the form of Patna Division II. The Board of LIC had in fact approved two new Divisions in this year- Patna II and Bardhaman (under Eastern Zone). With this, the total number of Divisions in LIC goes up to 112 Divisions. While the Senior Divisional Manager for the new Division had been finalized in the last week of April, the Branch Offices had not yet been finalized owing to some logistics problems.
