As scheduled, the one-day Working Committee meeting of ECZIEA was held in the KIIT campus Bhubaneswar on 02.03.2025 under the aegis of BDLIEA. Deemed to be a preparatory meeting for the upcoming **27th Platinum Jubilee Year General Conference of AIIEA** to be held in the same venue towards the end of December 2025, the WC meeting set the ball rolling for the success of the same. The meeting commenced at about 10.00am with Com Pradip Mukherjee in the chair. After the condolence resolution, Com President gave a brief objective of the meeting. Thereafter Com Trinath Dora, General Secretary while delivering his address thanked the AIIEA leaders for giving opportunity to host the 27th General conference of AIIEA for the first time after 17 years of formation of ECZIEA. Very briefly yet succinctly he placed before the house about the activities to be carried out preceding the conference, for spreading the message and objective of the conference in a very befitting manner. He outlined a number of suggestions to be undertaken across the Zone by all the 11 divisions and appealed the members present to properly schedule the activities. Important among his suggestions were holding state level conventions on subjects like Insurance Laws' Amendment Bill 2025, Strength of cultural diversity and unity, Constitution as a living document and Strong LIC for stronger India. He also suggested for undertaking social work, improving policy servicing, cultural programme of appropriate themes, blood donation camps, on-line quiz among staff and field forces and campaign on social media platforms. But a conference to be successful the fund to be generated is the foremost. As such he emphasized not only to fulfill but also to exceed the target set for the Zone. Expressing satisfaction over the continuing collection of BDLIEA, the host unit, he appealed the leaders of rest of the divisions to complete their respective divisional target and remit the entire amount latest by September 2025.

It was very much pleasure to have Com Shreekant Mishra and Com B S Ravi, the General Secretary and Treasurer of AIIEA respectively, which enthused the members of the WC. Speaking on the occasion Com Ravi outlined about some meticulous preparations to be performed. He informed the house that, this conference may see highest numbers of

participants with about 2000 delegates and observers, which may include 550 women comrades.

Referring to the largest religious congregation in the Kumbhmela at Praygaraj, Com Shreekant Mishra expressed apprehension about how difficult will be our future task to save our constitution and the mosaic culture of our country. Era of neo-fascism has already arrived he cautioned. He exhorted to understand the real intention of the govt. behind the implementation of One Nation, One Election and the manner it is campaigned extensively to hoodwink the Indian mass, from the livelihood issues they are facing. Considering the way the BDLIEA is in preparation since Jan 2024, he was very confident that the upcoming AIIEA conference will surpass all the past conferences.

Participating in the debates 14 speakers from all the 11 divisions assured the house of over fulfilling the targets set and also extend physical help, if so required by the host unit. The exuberance exhibited by each of the speaker, did not left an iota of doubt about the success of the conference and Com Bharat Bhushan Nayak, President, BDLIEA who during his speech expressed a sense of relief, besides narrating about the on- going preparations till date.

The minor skepticism expressed by Com Pradip Mukherjee at the start of meeting, turned out to convincing optimism towards his concluding speech. He was confident and assured the All India leaders of a never-before hosting of the AIIEA conference.

Thus the WC meeting came to an end with a very positive note and all the leaders and comrades alike were confident of overcoming every odd, transforming whatever adversity to utter opportunity to make the 27th General Conference a thumping success.
